ATTACHMENT 1: Intermediate Rider Award

Attention SAERA committee and members

I would like to raise a proposal to be heard at our 2017 AGM, with intent to pass a motion within appropriate processes at our AGM.

I would like to see an intermediate rider award recognised at the end of each calendar year. The award would be for intermediate riders and horses only. Each horse and rider pair would earn points for successful completion kilometres ridden. And lose points for unsuccessful events. Additional points to be accrued/lost for certain parameters through horse management and identifiable through the vet gate, ie heart rates, metabolic, gait and so on.

I would propose a intermediate membership be created to ensure riders wishing to compete in the overall point score would be necessary to contribute towards costs. However the membership should be such that it encourages members and participants. For example less than full riding membership, membership should be afforded voting rights. Members have the option to extend to full membership mid yearly at the monetary value between fully riding member and proposed intermediate membership. Intermediate members would not be eligible to enter 80 km rides unless extending membership to full riding.

Yearly points scores would be awarded a printed certificate with points tally, overall winner awarded a perpetual trophy.

I believe this may encourage participants who currently compete under day membership to become members. I strongly believe we need to support and foster new members and participants and that this will encourage people to work towards and end of year goal.

I am hoping to discuss this more proposal in further detail at our end of year AGM.
