



## SAERA Bib Policy

As of 2012 it is mandatory for all Qualified SAERA members wishing to compete in 80km events and above to have their own bibs. Novice riders will be exempted until they gain open status. If you are a member and wish to have a bib for 'training and introductory rides' also you may order one. You will be provided with a training strip to Velcro on your bib for training rides. As voted in 2009/10 AGM's, please refer to full policy on our website, [www.saeraonline.com.au](http://www.saeraonline.com.au) We made the bibs available to members in 2011, they are mandatory in 2013. The bibs are a High Visibility Vest yellow in colour and will have night The price of the bibs will be at a cost to members at \$32 per bib.. The bibs will be a one off purchase, however replacement bibs may be purchased at any time. Your riding number will be the your membership number. Please note this is not negotiable as this is your AERA number and a number given is for life. This number is then to be used at every ride you enter 80km and above and you will have this riding number for the duration of your career, it can be used on multiple horses. Should you forget your bib when at a ride, SAERA bibs will be available, though this will not be accepted on a regular basis. A SAERA bib will be supplied until your ordered bib has arrived. Please note that we also can not order bibs until we have received paid applications, until then a current SAERA bib will be supplied.
