

RULES FOR TOWING THE RIDE TRAILER

- 1. Do not tow the ride trailer if your tow vehicle is not legally able to tow 3000kgs or greater and must be equipped with an electric brake unit.**
- 2. Do not load the trailer with ANYTHING behind the red line painted on the floor when towing.**
- 3. Do not tow the trailer loaded at speeds faster than 90km/hr.**
- 4. Check all tyre pressures are at 48PSI**
- 5. The trailer has 2 yellow two tonne rated D shackles for attaching the safety chains to the tow vehicle. These must always be used to tow with and left on the chains with the trailer at all times.**
- 6. If you suspect that any repairs or maintenance is required on the trailer, please do NOT attempt to undertake this task, refer instead any concerns to the ride trailer coordinator.**

The ride trailer is a heavy trailer. If you are not experienced with towing a heavy trailer or do not feel confident to do so please DO NOT tow it. If you do choose to tow the trailer you are accepting that you will abide by the above rules.
